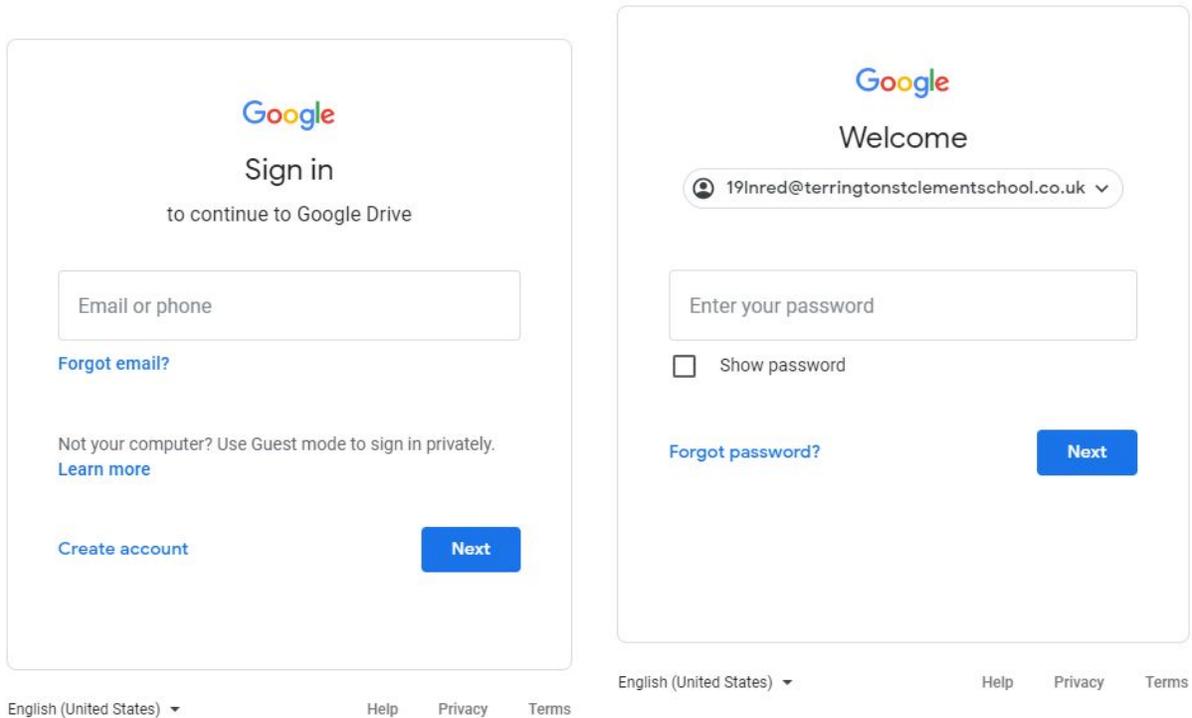
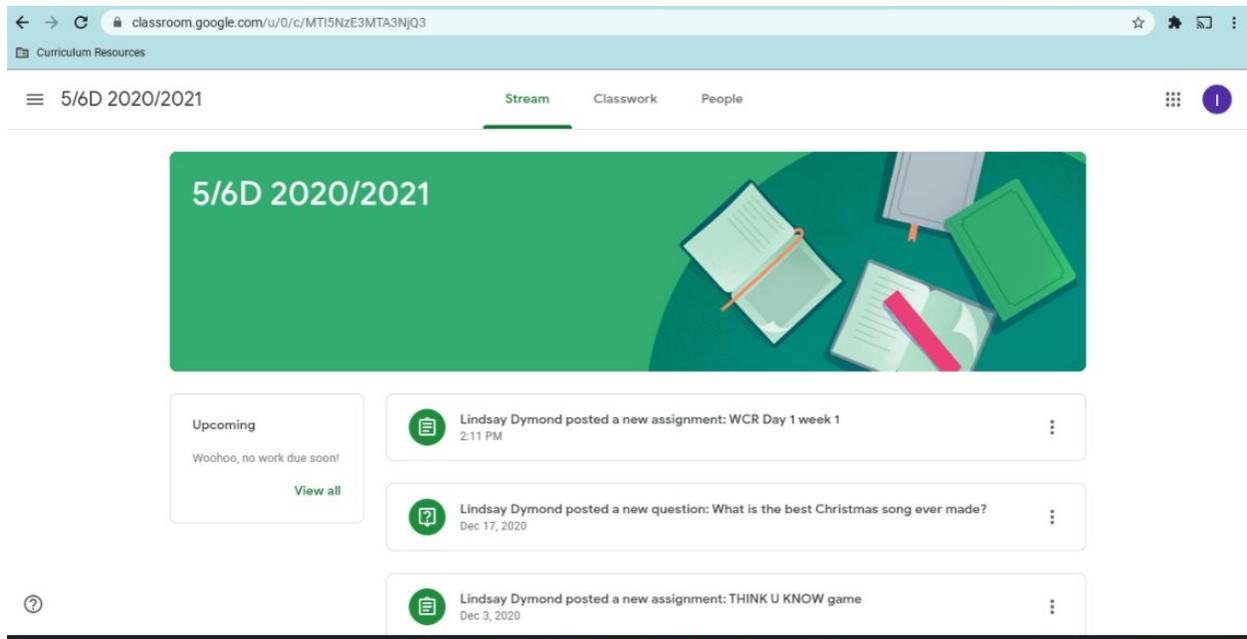


Go to google and login using their school email address. This ends in @terringtonstclementschoo.co.uk
