
Hopefully everyone has now applied for tickets to watch the Christmas performances. As you know, we have added an extra performance as the number of tickets was far greater than we expected.

We are looking for local parents/carers across Norfolk, who make good use of local services, are friendly and enjoy chatting with other parents/carers.


Parent Champions are volunteers who give a few hours a week to
