We've made it! I hope that you, like us are looking forward to a well earned break. I know our learners have worked extremely hard this year and are definitely in need of a few slower mornings.

At the end of this week, we say goodbye to our Year 6's. We are immensely proud of them and know they will move into their High School truly ready for the next stage in their learning. They have grown in confidence, maturity and shown us how responsible they can be. Whilst, we know that SATs results are only one small measure by which they are judged, I did want to share how delighted we are with our reading results this year. When nationally, standards dropped, our school achieved our very best results ever, despite the disruption to learning over the last few years. We exceeded the national average by 5%. We know it takes a whole school community to help our learners achieve so thank you to all of the parents/carers who read with your child, encourage them to love books and support in so many ways. It makes all of the difference!

This Friday, when you come to school, you will notice that a section of our playground has been fenced off. We are very excited that our Specialist Resource Base (SRB) located in the building at the rear of the field, is being revamped and updated to bring it up to current building standards and improve the learning environment for these learners. We have been fortunate to receive substantial funding from the LA to help achieve this. Our SRB supports up to 10 learners at a time with Speech, Language & Communication Needs. Learners travel from across West Norfolk.

I hope you have a lovely summer and look forward to seeing you all refreshed and raring to go in September. Learners **return to school on Wednesday 6th September.**
