Does Your Family Qualify for Extra Support?

If you think your child is entitled to free school meals, you can [click this link](#) and apply. If technology isn't your thing, don't panic, we will be sending home paper copies next week and you can post the form off once completed or return it to us.

You might not be aware that at the moment, the government is giving parents/carers a £15 food voucher per child each month. This is carrying on until at least October.

We also receive additional funding of £1,480 per child a large proportion of which helps us fund our support staff and ensures that there is support for all pupils to learn and feel settled in school.

Upcoming Changes to School Charges

As you will be aware from your own budgeting, costs continue to rise albeit at a slightly slower rate than we have experienced over the past year. We are very mindful of this and have worked hard to absorb as much of these increases as possible. However, it is necessary to make small increases to our charges from next year. The changes are detailed below.

Nursery Charges

Increasing from £4 to £4.10 per hour
Lunchtime session remains at £2.25

Meal Charges

Increasing from £2.35 to £2.40

Breakfast Club

Increasing from £3.25 to £3.40
