Extended School/Before and After School Activities

Terrington St Clement Community School runs a variety of after school clubs and a Breakfast Club. In addition we host the church's Rock Zone club.

Aims

We aim to:

- offer a wide range of activities before and after school giving pupils the opportunity to develop and further their potential
- offer a secure and safe environment in which pupils can take part in extended school activities
- offer a balance of arts, sports, social and educational activities
- ensure the activities are regularly monitored and the provider carries out appropriate risk assessments and is aware of the safety procedures in the school .
- provide as many clubs free of charge and where an outsider charge is required, we will subsidise the cost.
- Offer a calm start to the school day with a nourishing breakfast.

The school will provide:

- A safe, clean, and secure environment.
- clearly demarcated roles and responsibilities between the school and the providers and all health and safety checks are in place
- support and encouragement to providers in order to build a relationship based on trust
- inclusive activities which are in keeping within the inclusive ethos of the school
- safety checks which have been carried out on the provider with regard to DBS and references.
- Safe ratios of adult to pupils, taking into account the amount of space and the type of activity
- Clear arrangements and procedures at times when a pupil is not Collected on time or an unknown person come to collect a child,
- A senior member of staff who will remain on duty until the club has finished and all pupils safely collected.
- Standards of behaviour which match those expected during the school day.
